

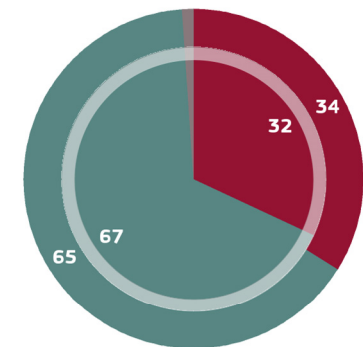

(%)

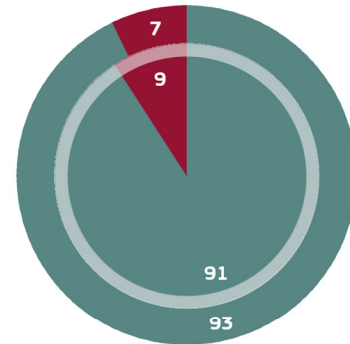

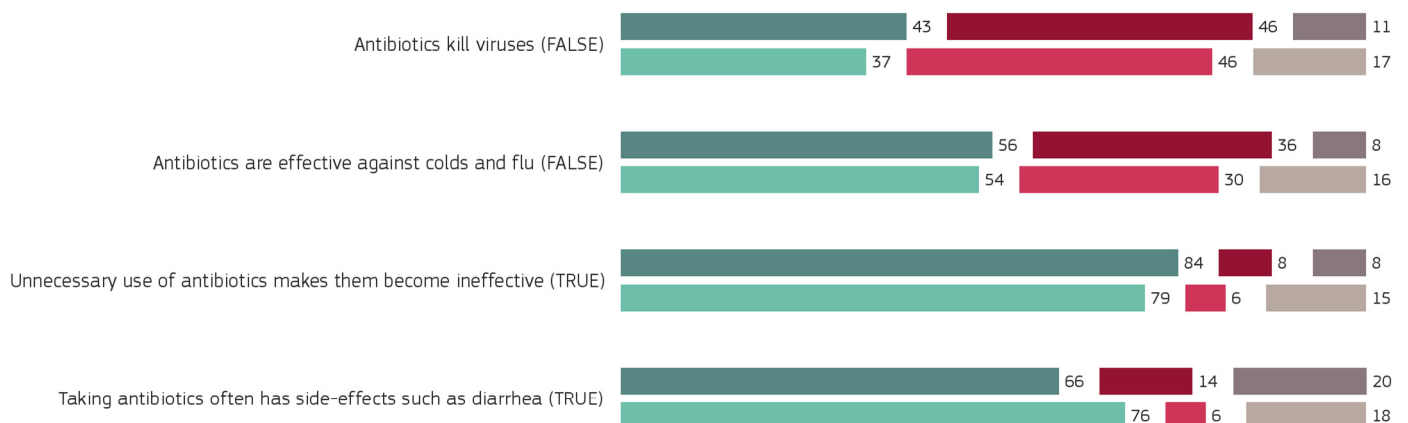

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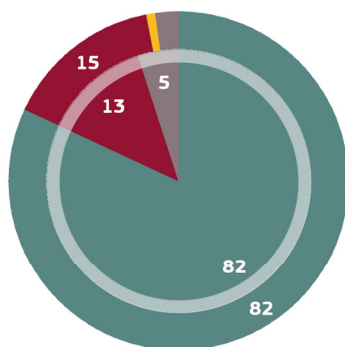

(%)



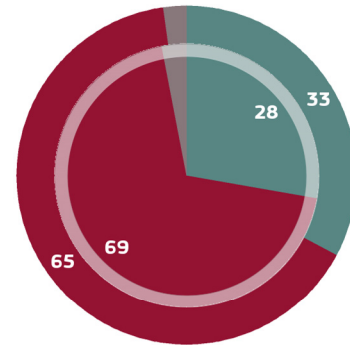

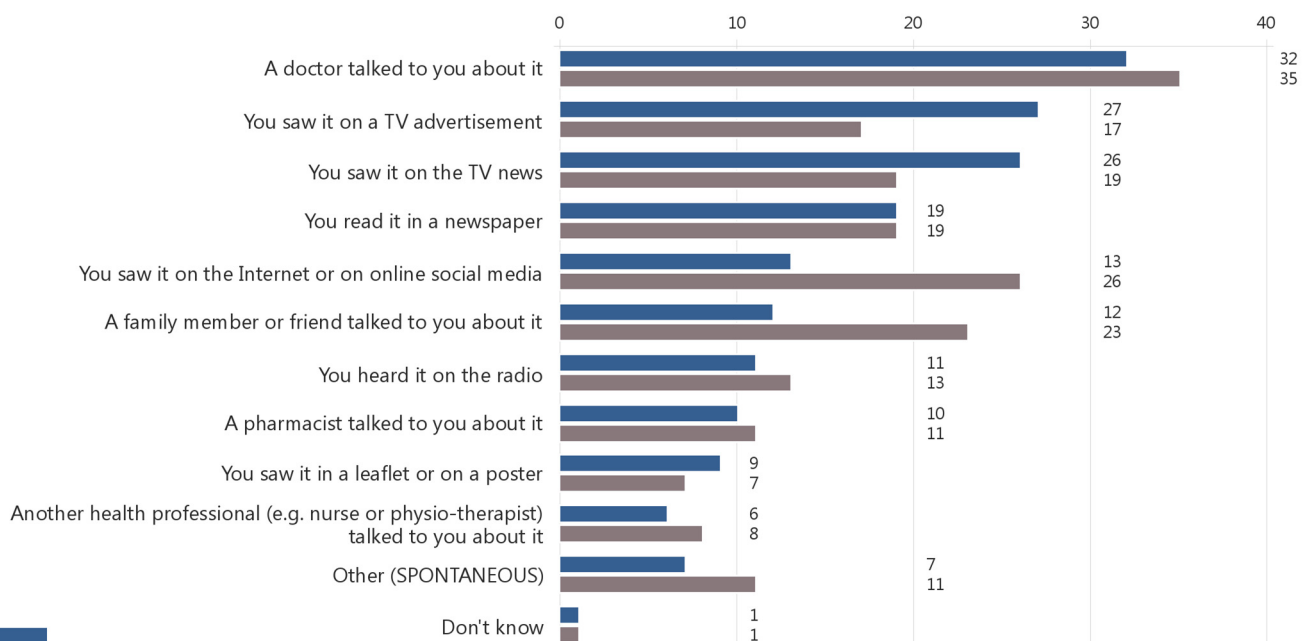

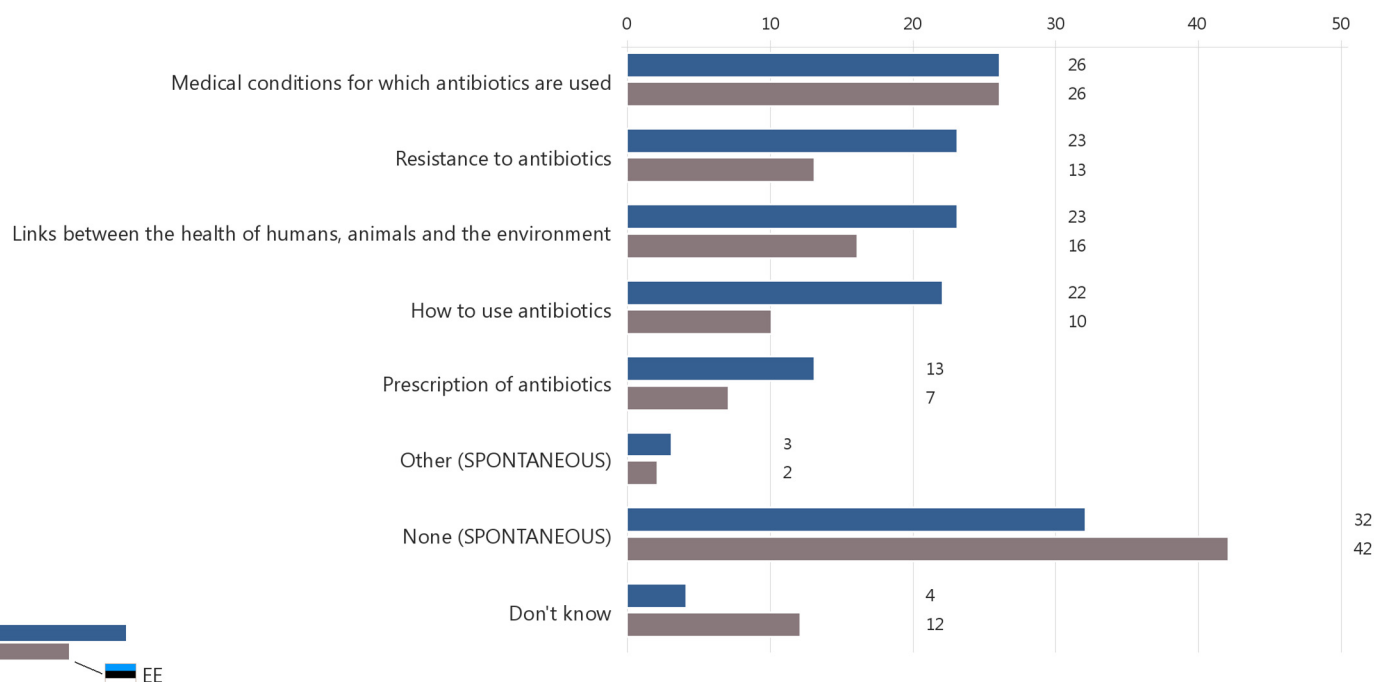
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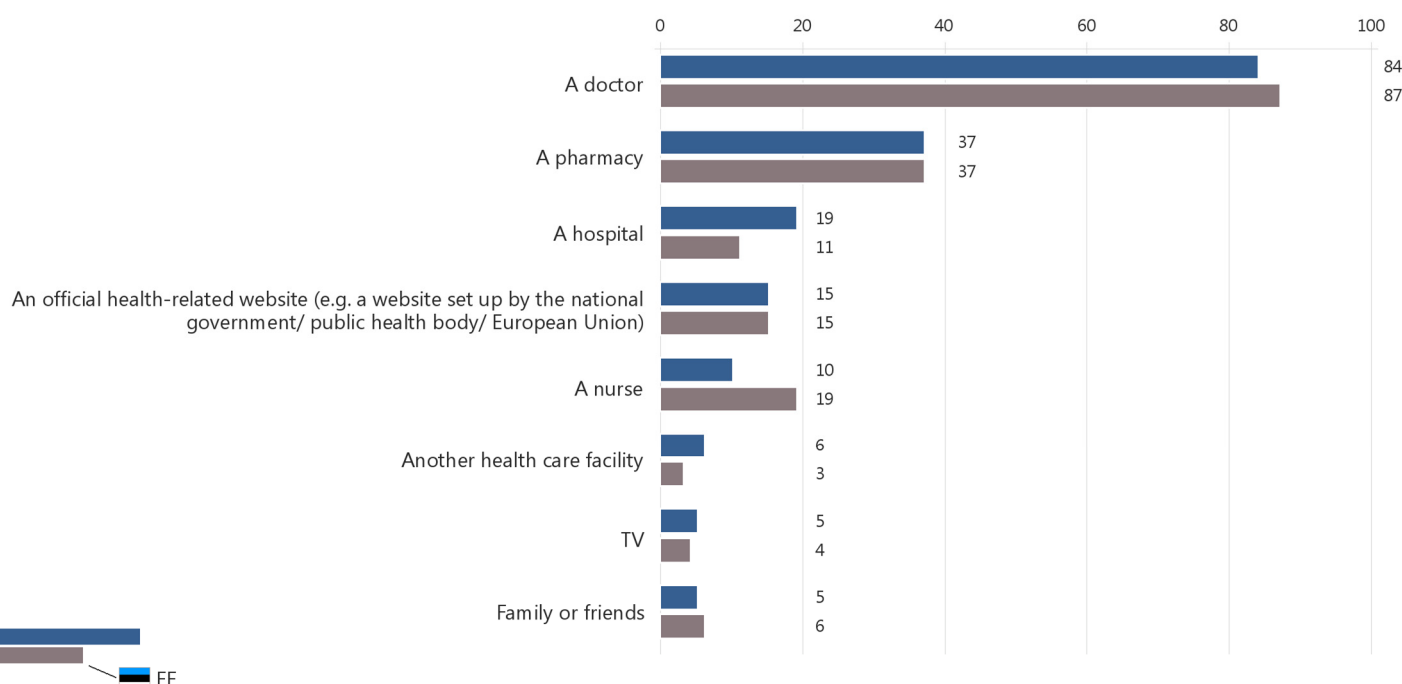

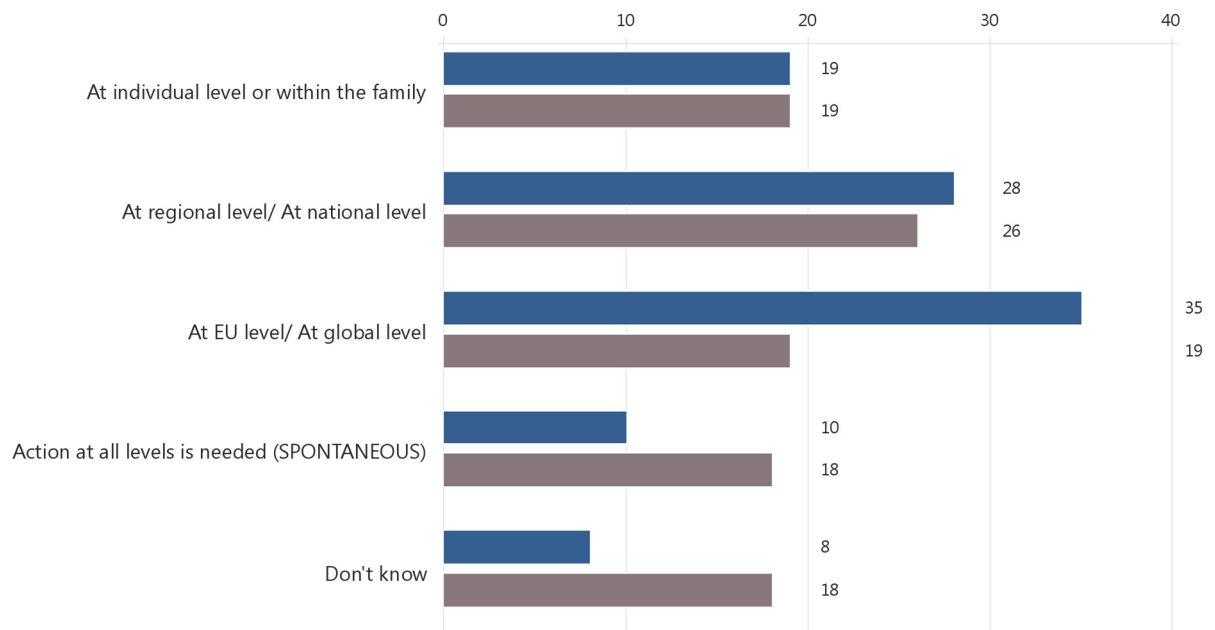
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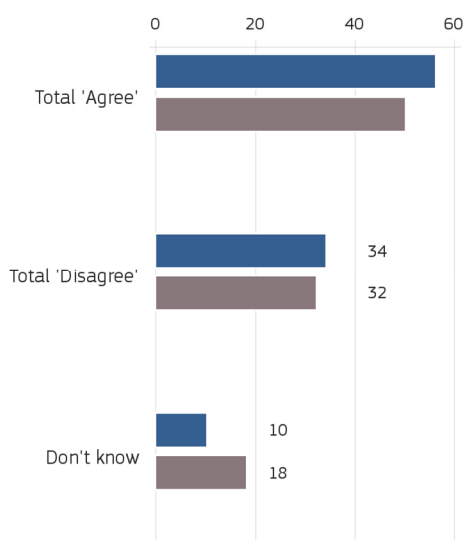
5. MOST EFFECTIVE LEVEL TO TACKLE ANTIMICROBIAL RESISTANCE
